POINT ROAD DRESS CODE

Students are expected to dress neatly and appropriately for school. Dress or appearance that distracts from the educational process is not permitted and students unsuitably dressed may be requested to return home to change into appropriate clothing or may result in parents/guardians having to bring a change of clothing to school.

The following dress code has been developed in accordance with district:

- A. Clothing with inappropriate language or messages (implied or stated) and images are not acceptable.
- B. Shoes must be worn at all times. No backless footwear is permitted (including flip flops).
- C. Hats, caps or head coverings are not permitted inside the school.
- D. Sneakers are required for gym, sneakers with wheels or “heelies” are not permitted under any circumstances.
- E. Students should not bring or wear expensive items such as jewelry, CD players, iPods, etc. to school as the school will not be responsible for theft or loss.

Students that are not in compliance with the school dress code will be sent to the main office. Along with acquiring appropriate clothes, a disciplinary consequence may be enforced.
