

STUDENT GRIEVANCE PROCEDURE

The Little Silver Board of Education believes that students are citizens who possess the right to request redress of grievances and that students should be encouraged to respect lawful procedures for the resolution of disputes. The superintendent or designee shall establish and maintain procedures for student grievances and appeals beyond the decision of the principal. Details of those procedures should be made known to students and staff, and students who wish to use them should be assured of access to the appropriate personnel within a reasonable period of time.
