

Policy

PUBLIC PERFORMANCES

The Little Silver Board of Education recognizes the value to students of sharing their talents and skills with the community through participation and performances in public events.

The Board endorses such performances when:

- A. They constitute a learning experience which contributes to the educational program;
- B. They do not interfere with other scheduled activities of the school; and
- C. The circumstances of the event do not pose a threat to the health, safety, and well-being of the students who will be involved.

All requests for public performances by students require the approval of the superintendent who shall report same to the board. The superintendent shall develop procedures to implement this policy which require that parental permission be sought and received before students may participate, and no student be compelled to participate in a public performance or penalized in any way for failure to do so.
