#### **ORGANIZATION MEETING**

The Little Silver Board of Education shall organize annually at a regular meeting after the November election on any day of the first week in January.

The meeting shall be called to order by the school business administrator/board secretary, who shall serve as presiding officer pro tempore until the election of a president and vice president.

The board secretary shall administer the oath of office to new board members.

## Annual Motions and Designations

The board shall at the organizational meeting:

- A. Designate one or more depositories for school funds, N.J.S.A. 18A:17-34;
- B. Designate those persons authorized to sign school warrants, N.J.S.A. 18A:19-1;
- C. Designate the official newspaper, N.J.S.A. 18A:22-11; 18A:39-3;
- D. Designate a second newspaper for the publication of Board meetings, N.J.S.A. 10:4-8;
- E. Designate the day, place, and time for regular meetings of the Board;
- F. Approve the curriculum for all grades;
- G. Readopt existing bylaws and policies for the Board's operation and the operation of the school system.
