

Bylaw

BOARD SELF-EVALUATION

The members of the Little Silver Board of Education shall conduct an annual self-evaluation to determine the degree to which they are meeting their responsibilities as board members and the needs of their educational community. This self-evaluation shall be positive, frank and honest, and shall be the board's professional development improvement plan that establishes priorities for action and specific goals and objectives to strengthen the operation of the board.

The board shall use a multifaceted self-evaluation instrument.

The assessments of board members will be tabulated and presented for discussion at a regular meeting of the board in which the superintendent will be invited to participate.
